Thoughts from the Mind and Heart of Fr. Chad...

Update on the New Sound System!

You may remember that several months ago we had two different speakers demonstrated in preparation for the new sound system in the Church. While I heard your feedback on both, I told you that the Pastoral Council and I would decide which is the best for our space and that we would have it installed when we raised the \$58,000 for it through the Pink Envelope Building Improvement Fund. Thanks to your generosity, we have raised enough money and so it is coming very soon! Our new sound system will be **installed** during the **week of Oct 24th!**

For the most part, the feedback you gave was that both speakers sounded much better than our current system. Knowing that they were also comparable in cost, we chose to go with the new technology flat panel speakers from Tectonics. These speakers allow for a better and more evenly distributed sound in the entire space while diminishing the echo sound bouncing off the walls and floor. Please understand that it will take an adjustment for our ears to hear the sound coming from the front of the Church (where the sound should naturally be heard from) rather than from the speakers on the sides. Although it will sound different, I trust it will sound much better by everyone in the Church no matter where one sits.

A couple of weeks ago a long time parishioner told me that he had not heard one homily in several years, but yet he still comes to Mass to receive Holy Communion. Can you imagine not being able to hear a word at Mass? While I thanked him for his faithfulness in receiving our Lord, I said how sorry I was for him not being able to hear anything and how I hope the new sound system will help. While I know that this new sound system will solve the problem with the ‘dead spots’ throughout the Church, I also understand that there are some people who still won’t be able to hear well; not because of the sound system, but because of their own hearing disabilities. This new sound system will include a few new devices (with new technology) for personal use during Mass by individuals who have difficulty hearing. Please see an Usher for one after it is installed. I certainly hope and pray that the new speakers, as well as the new individual hearing sets, will help greatly.

The same company who will be installing the sound system in the Church, gave us a quote for updating the sound system in the Parish Center too. Upon learning about the equipment that they would install using our pre-existing speakers, and after receiving the quote, Steve, our Parish Manager, thought with his background in electrical engineering, that he (and our Maintenance staff) could install it for a fraction of the cost. Thanks to the work of Steve and the Maintenance staff, the new Sound system in the Parish Center is already installed for \$15,000 dollars less than the quoted price! I hope that shows that your Parish Staff and I are trying to be good stewards of what you give for the good of the parish, not only in the tithing with the normal Sunday collections but also in the Pink Envelope gifts.

Now that the immediate needed updates to our worship space are completed (the sound system and LED lighting), the next little Pink Envelope projects will be LED lights in the offices and classrooms, as well as the parking lots. With these new lights, we will have LED throughout the campus, and thus will be saving even more in our electricity bills. Thank you so much for your generosity. I am excited to see how the improved sound will help us give glory to God!





Feasts of the Week

Tuesday, October 11th:

Pope John XXIII — Born of a farming family in Sotto il Monte in Northern Italy in 1881, Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli was ordained a priest in 1904. After serving in World War I as a stretcher-bearer, he was later made national director of the Society for the Propagation of the Faith. In 1925 he became a papal diplomat, serving in Bulgaria, Turkey, and in France. With the help of Germany's ambassador to Turkey, Roncalli helped save an estimated 24,000 Jewish people during World War II. Named a cardinal and appointed patriarch of Venice in 1953 by Pope Pius XII, he was elected pope in 1958 at age seventy-eight. He took the name John after his father and the two patrons of Rome's cathedral, St. John Lateran. In 1959, he convoked the Second Vatican Council, which took place from 1962-1965. His most famous encyclicals were *Mater et Magister* (1961) and *Pacem in Terris* (1963). "Good Pope John" died of stomach cancer on June 3, 1963. Today, his feast day, recalls the day of the first session of the Second Vatican Council in 1962. Declared a Blessed in 2000, he was canonized, together with Pope John Paul II, by Pope Francis on April 27, 2014.

Friday, October 14th:

Pope Callistus I, † 222; incurred the ire of Tertullian and Hippolytus over *lapsi* controversy; organized the first official Christian cemetery in Rome and instituted Ember Day fasts.

Saturday, October 15th:

Teresa of Avila, (Teresa of Jesus), † 1582 at Alba; Spanish mystic who, with St. John of the Cross, founded the reformed (Discalced) Carmelite friars and nuns, for which she had to endure great trials; authored *Way of Perfection*, *Interior Castle*, and an autobiography; first woman declared "Doctor of the Church"; patroness of Spain.





FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What does it mean to be a registered parishioner?

How do I register? All Catholics living within the Parish and regularly participating in the liturgy are invited to register in the Parish. **Church attendance alone does NOT make you and your family registered members.** Registration is required for Baptism, First Communion, First Reconciliation, Confirmation, Marriage and Catholic Education programs.

Adult children, 18⁺, need to be registered separately from their parents in order to get married, have their own children baptized, or be Godparents or Sponsors.

Also, in order to be a Godparent or Sponsor or receive discounted tuition rates at Catholic Schools, one must be a registered Catholic and active in the parish, which is indicated by use of contribution envelopes or the Online Giving program.

You can register by coming to the Parish Office and filling out a short registration form. The registration form can also be downloaded from our parish website.

How do I have my child Baptized? Before scheduling the date, please call the Office for a welcoming conversation with the priest. Preparation classes are also required for parents prior to the child's Baptism and are offered once a month.

How do I request a Communion Call or Anointing of the Sick? Please call the parish office at 480-893-8770. **DO NOT WAIT until someone is near death to have the person anointed!** Although Anointing of the Sick was once known as "Last Rites," waiting until a person is near death could risk that person not being able to receive the Sacrament if he or she should pass away prior to the priest being able to arrive. Anointing of the Sick can only be administered while the person is still alive.

How do I get married in the Church? The Diocese of Phoenix requires a **NINE MONTH** marriage preparation process. John Deg, Director of Married Life Ministries, will meet with you to explain the process, including when you will meet with the Pastor to set a date. **Do NOT set the date** prior to this meeting as it cannot be guaranteed until then.
